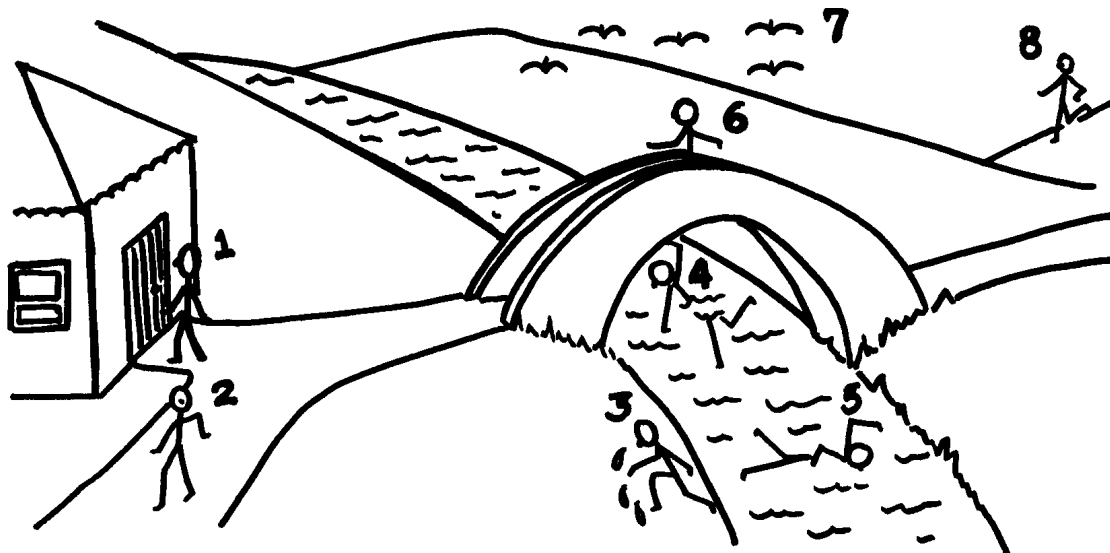


Prepositions

Complete the sentences, using the following prepositions: *up, down, along, across, over, under, into, out of*.

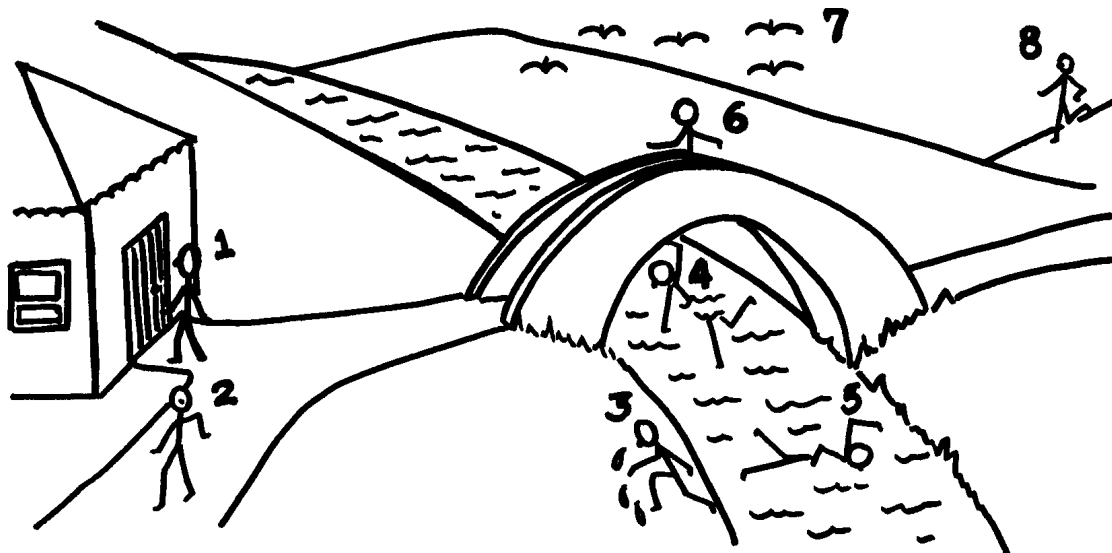


NOTE: The numbers in the picture correspond to the numbers below.
